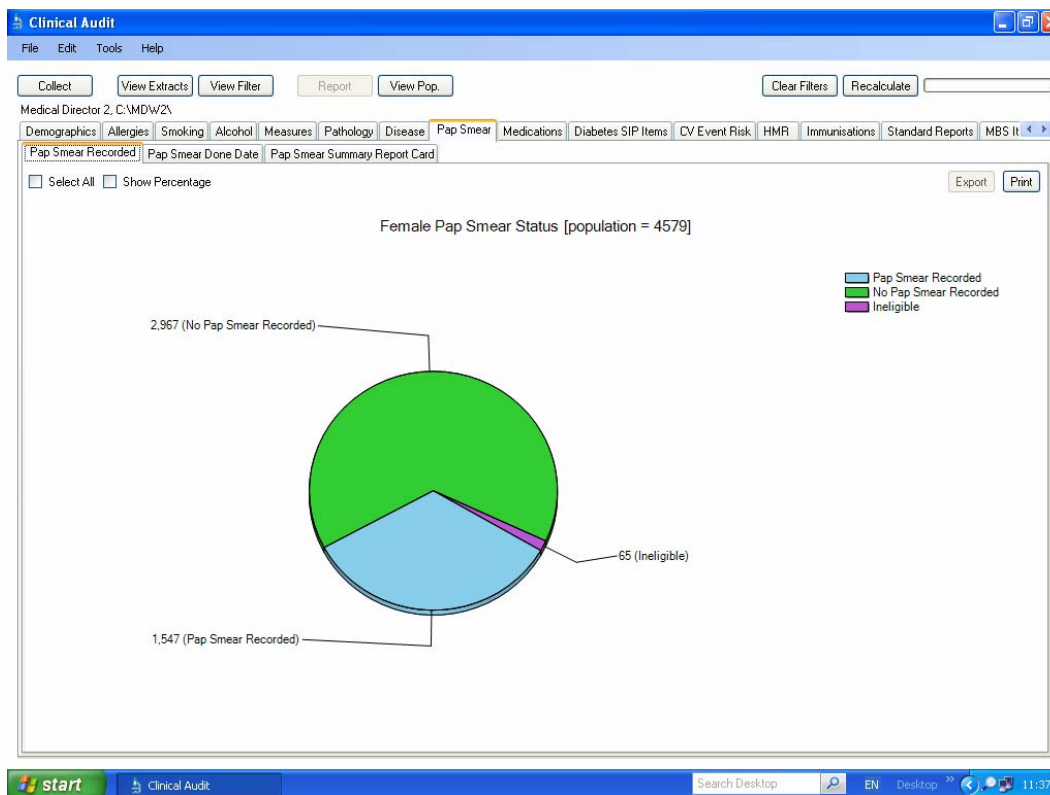


Pen Clinical Audit Tool: Cervical Smear Screening and Preventative Check

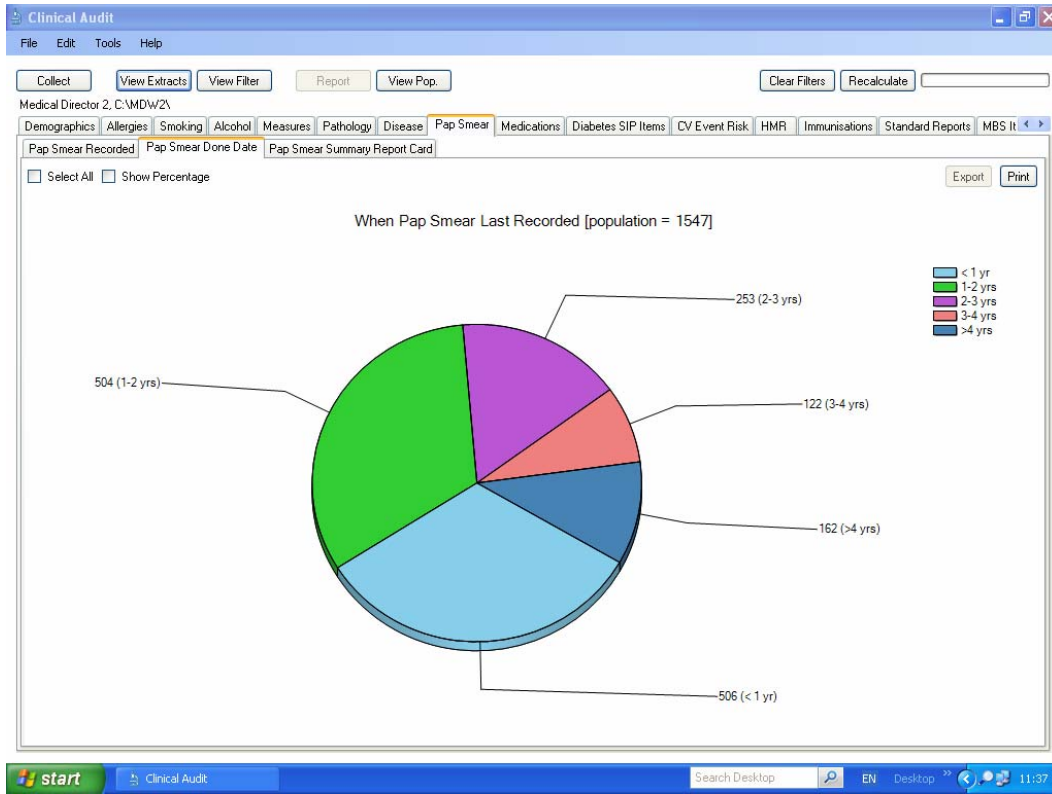
Item numbers 10994 & 10995 can be conducted by a qualified practice nurse credentialed in taking cervical smears. Services for items 10994 and 10995 must include a pap smear and at least one preventative check such as checking for sexually transmitted diseases. In instances where the practice nurse is not qualified she/he can still assist by identifying those women who are due or overdue for their cervical smear. To claim 10995, the woman, aged between 20 and 69 and not have had the service in the previous 4 years. Both items have a rebate of \$22.70.

How to use your CAT to identify who are due or overdue for a cervical smear:

- Press ‘Collect’ to extract a new data file, or click on an existing extract
- Click ‘Hide Extracts’
- Click ‘View Filter’
- For the item number 10995 only: On the ‘General’ tab, under the ‘Age’ column, type in a ‘Start Age’ of 20, and an ‘End Age’ of 69
- Under the ‘Last Visit’ column, select ‘Active (3 x < 2 years)’
- Click ‘Recalculate’
- Click ‘Hide Filter’
- Click on the ‘Pap Smear’ tab – the first tab that will open up will be ‘Pap Smear Recorded’ as shown below. This graph details the number of women who fit into the categories of Pap Smear Recorded, No Pap Smear Recorded and Ineligible. Women who fall into the ineligible category include patients who are flagged in the clinical system as not requiring a pap smear or who have a coded condition recorded that excludes them (e.g. hysterectomy).



- Of those patients who have a pap smear recorded, you can then determine how many years it has been since they had one completed. The second tab 'Pap Smear Done Date' divides the women by number of years since last pap smear from <1 years, 1-2 years, 2-3 years, 3-4 years and >4 years as shown below.



- By selecting each segment of the pie you can identify which women fall into each category.

- Using your clinical software set up a recall for each patient identified as ‘at risk’. Using your recall and reminder systems, practice staff could then follow-up with the women identified in the CAT search, and where necessary provide the patient with any women’s health information.

Pap Smear Summary Report Card

- The third tab under ‘Pap Smear’ is the Pap Smear Summary Report Card (please note that this report is always derived from your full dataset not your filtered dataset).
- The Pap Smear Summary Report Card is an initiative of the SA Cervix Screening Program (SACSP) to improve the management of clinical information related to cervical screening and support increased participation of women in screening. This report card can be printed and used as a reference tool, or can exported and saved either as an excel document or a pdf document.
